BCHS choral groups perform winter concert next week

The Choral department at Beaverhead County High School will present a winter concert Wednesday, December 15 at 7:30 p.m. in the high school auditorium. All choral groups will participate in the concert that will include music of the holiday season.

All groups will open the concert with a processional "Personent Hodie", based on a 14th century German melody.

The Treble Chorus and Teen Tones will follow with "Alleluia" by Mozart, and "Silver Bells" will be sung by the Treble Chorus.

The men of the chorus will present a Christmas spiritual, "Who's That Baby?" and a Hanukkah piece. A barbershop arrangement of

"Jingle Bells" will be performed by the Barbershop Quartet.

The Mixed Ensemble will sing "Gloria" from Antonio Vivaldi's Gloria and an cappella arrangement of "Deck the Halls", which is a piece written for the winter solstice.

The Teen Tones will entertain with a selection of carols and Donald Fraser's "This Christmastide".

"This Christmastide" is also known as "Jessy's Carol" and was written for the diva Jessy Norman.

All members will present the finale, the traditional "Hallelujah Chorus" from Handel's Messiah.

Laurie Hagenbarth is the director of choirs at BCBS. The students of the choral department invite the public to attend the free concert.
