There will be two divisions to this new department, one will be conducted primarily for those interested in bookkeeping and stenography, the other for students interested in secretarial work. The purpose of the courses is to offer training on the college level for persons interested in secretarial training or bookkeeping. Two years are required for graduation in the proposed department.

A complete line of business equipment will be installed to provide practical training in all office machines.
