

# CAMPUS SCHOOL BASKETBALL RESUME'

Basketball teams from Eastern's Campus School completed their individual 1958-59 basketball schedules last week and moved on in a futile attempt to gain tournament laurels in action recently.

Final standings in the Grade School League were released by the Department of Public Recreation Monday. The youngsters participate in the program under the supervision of the Billings Recreation Department.

The Campus school was represented by three separate teams, from the Fourth, Fifth and Sixth grades.

The Eastern Gladiators, Sixth grade chargers, finished out the season with 9 wins against four losses to place number four on the league

ledger. The fifth grade aggregation, "Eastern Yellowjackets", ended up near the bottom with four wins and nine losses for a sixth place standing. The Yellowjacket's record looks vaguely familiar. "Eastern's Blobs", the fourth grade crew, finished out the season in fifth place with a 3 and 8 final.

A grade school tournament was staged recently but the local round-ballers failed to place as all three teams lost out in the opening rounds of the single elimination tourney. The Broadwater Wolverines downed the Yellowjackets in a close 13 to 10 thriller. McKinley's Colts smothered the Blobs 10 to 2, and the Fratt Bombers stormed over the Gladiators in a wild scoring free-for-all, 4 to 3.

1. Scan the material to get an over-all picture.

2. Read material thoroughly, often several times.

3. Close book and see how much you remember. You can write the main points down or make an outline if this will help.

4. Go through the material again. Underline the important facts and make a complete outline. Never underline or make an outline until you have gone over the material thoroughly.

You should find a method best suited to you whereby you can do your lessons thoroughly in a short time. The library has many books on study habits to give you further aid. "Effective Study" by F. P. Robinson is an excellent book. Besides giving worthwhile suggestions, it contains tests to give yourself.

## Ev Shelton Leaves Wyoming Cowboys

Ev Shelton resigned Monday after 20 years as University of Wyoming basketball coach. Shelton said he was accepting the head basketball coaching job at another college institution whose athletic program is "less demanding."

In 19 seasons at Wyoming, Shelton's teams won eight Skyline championships. His Wyoming record is 329 victories and 199 losses and his over-all collegiate coaching mark is 391 triumphs and 209 losses.

Shelton's 1943 team, led by Kenny Sailors, Milo Komenich and Jim Weir, won the NCAA championship. Wyoming's last Skyline Conference championship came in 1958. Shelton is 60.
