Winifred High School will sponsor a student book fair from May 5 to May 7. Students will be able to browse and purchase books. The book fair will be open during the hours of 8:30-3:30. Books will be on display in the English room.

The book fair committee invites all students, parents, and visitors to attend the fair. The fair will not only help spur student interest in reading and building home libraries, but will also contribute to a worthwhile project. The school earns 20% of all sales and profits will be used for junior class activities.

The book fair display will include attractive new books from many publishers in all popular price ranges. All reading areas of interest to students will be represented, including classics, fiction, biographies, adventure stories, science, nature, crafts, mystery, and reference books. The committee is working with Educational Reading Service, a professional book fair company, to furnish an individual selection of books for the fair.

The banquet will be on April 30 in the school gym. Speaker for the evening is scheduled to be Mr. J. A. Longin, Dean of Admissions at the College of Great Falls. Musical entertainment will be provided by the Chorales from Ferguson County High School.
