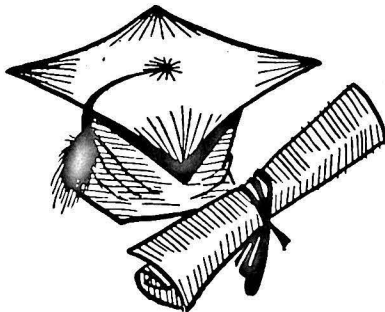
## Schools Out!
