## Western Heritage Assembly

"The Western Heritage Program" is the fourth Inspirada American program to be developed by singer/songwriter Phil White Hawk and artist Connie Bellet.

It begins in the timeless mists of prehistory with the culture and spirituality of the Native Americans. Then, into the ancient civilizations of the Southwest charge the Conquistadores, lusting for the Seven Cities of Gold, called Cibola. Other adventurers follow, but these adopt the ways of the native peoples, and are welcome. They are the early Voyageurs, and then, following the Louisiana Purchase, the furtrapping Mountain Men. Succeeding waves of population wash over the West, and each is marked by its own philosophical ideals and goals.

Collecting the hundreds of slides in this show has entailed thousands of miles of travel to seldom glimpsed ruins, the building of a 36 foot birchbark Voyageur canoe, the aid and abettment of the Northwest Rendezvous Group of Artists and the Paradise Valley Free Trappers, with a special contribution by artist Veryl Goodnight and her studio manager, Wendy Shattil.

Experiencing this program is a chance to share the adventure of living history.
