# Hypothermia

You are not a polar bear! Montanans need to be aware of  
 the dangers of hypothermia—both indoors and outdoors.  
 Hypothermia means the body has dangerously lost heat  
 and medical help is needed.

The Montana Energy Safety Council advises you to learn  
 what causes hypothermia, how to spot its symptoms and  
 the first aid measures that could save a life!

**Causes:**  
 ■ Prolonged exposure to mild cold (30° - 60°F)  
 ■ Extreme cold or immersion in cold water  
 ■ Wind chill

**Symptoms:**  
 ■ Shivering that may lessen or stop  
 ■ Disorientation  
 ■ Slurred speech

**First Aid:**  
 ■ Warm victim with blankets  
 ■ DO NOT give victim alcohol  
 ■ Get immediate medical help
