Notice is hereby given that the town council of the Town of Choteau, Montana, at its regular meeting, held on May 25th, 1914, ordered concrete walk and curbs constructed along the following streets:

All walk and curb remaining unbuild at the expiration of thirty days (30) will be built by the town sidewalk contractor and all costs assessed as a special tax to the abutting property, all in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 24 of the town of Choteau, Mont.
